

This is an open letter to State of New Jersey, Gov. Chris Christie, the New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (“NJOHSP”), and to all who are concerned:

We at Vanguard America write in response to the NJOHSP article of June 12, 2017 called “The Face of White Supremacy in 2017,” and specifically to inform you that we find no reason or evidence to accept your classification and claims against our organization.

First off, there is no reason to classify every group that promotes “white” interests as a white supremacist group. (“White” being a shorthand reference to those of European decent.)

**So, we must ask: Does the State of New Jersey hold all white people are supremacist? More so, are white people automatically classified as “supremacists” when they acknowledge their own demographic and work in the interests of that demographic? Does the State of New Jersey hold that white people are automatically terrorists when they act in the interest of their own demographic?**

For sake of public record, Vanguard America is NOT a white supremacist group. Instead, our emergence in the public realm is the result of a lack of representation of our people in local/national government institutions. (Again, our people being specifically those of European decent.) Our people have many grievances against local/national government legislation, judicial rulings, and enforcement of law, and we ask that they join us in pursuit of lawful recourse.

More so, we at Vanguard America understand many of our people feel their voice is suppressed, or worse, they feel they no longer have a voice in today’s government. And, haphazard articles like this NJOHSP statement inadvertently serve to edify their disheartened disposition. As such, one of our primary goals is to remedy this sense of despair by showing our people we are willing to stand up for them and secure their rights as a people. And, to our dismay, we find an article from NJOHSP seeking to vilify us without cause. And, for what? Because we dare to exercise our rights? In this case, specifically our right of free speech – because that’s all we’ve done thus far, and our intent is to uphold the rule of law because we are confident that truth and justice are on our side given, by and large,

- Our people still exist on these;
- We have a right to exist on these lands; and,
- We have a right to have institutions that represent our interests despite efforts to displace us.

Our people never voted to be replaced. Yet, from 1965 to today, our share of the population has dwindled from 90% to 62%. In light of our elite-designed

replacement, Vanguard is wholeheartedly committed towards ensuring the security of our people and their interests. White people have a right to be represented, and this suggestive classification by NJOHSP is exactly why we're needed, and why we gain community support everyday. Our people are waking up to a world where our institutions not only refuse to represent us, but actively try to vilify us for asserting our interests and rightful claims.

**So, again, with other words: Does the State of New Jersey hold that white people do not have a right to peacefully assemble? And, more so, that when we do assemble we're "supremacists" or "terrorists?"**

When government institutions, like this NJOHSP, present willy-nilly assessments to the public, then these institutions become fake news outlets that serve to poison the well, and thus corrupt public discourse. As our governing institutions join mainstream media in the obfuscation of truth, we at Vanguard America regret witnessing fellow whites concluding there is no lawful recourse for them, and thus feel they're at wits end which in return leads some to lash out against society at large while others silently commit suicide, and younger impressionable ones adopt self-mutilation under the guise of transgenderism just to fit in today's anti-white society.

We at Vanguard America denounce such violence against the self or violent reaction to government incompetence and/or oversight, and we will continue to use our collective voices to manifest positive change in this world by invoking the rule of law. After all, it was our forebearers that brought the rule of law to the West, and we seek to honor our forefathers for their gifts of civilization; we seek to honor our fallen brothers who have fought to preserve our way of life, and we seek to ensure the rights of the meek who these laws are intended to protect.

And, while we're on the topic of rule of law, reckless half truths like, "In April, Nathan Damigo—the founder of Identity Evropa—punched a woman at a protest in Berkeley, California," serve as prima facie evidence of the NJOHSP intent to engage in smear campaigns against a particular demographic, as well as the unwillingness for a government institution to grant white people the due process of law.

**So, to recap...**

**With a single, irresponsible article, the State of New Jersey has inadvertently abused police power to institute the following policy:**

- **Deny white people the due process of law;**
- **Deny white people the right to assemble peacefully; and,**
- **Deny white people the right of free speech.**

We at Vanguard America cordially ask Gov. Chris Christie to publicly and unambiguously reaffirm that his oath of office ensures that these rights are extended to white people; that white people do have a voice in today's government; and, that white people will have their grievances addressed in a court of law rather than mocked openly in the court of public opinion by an institution with police powers.

We further request an unambiguous public apology from Gov. Chris Christie and NJOHSP for these oversights, as well as a public apology to Nathan Damigo for defamation of character.

And, lastly, we request that the Gov. Chris Christie unambiguously reaffirm that the peaceful assembly of white people does not automatically make them racists; supremacists; or, terrorists.
